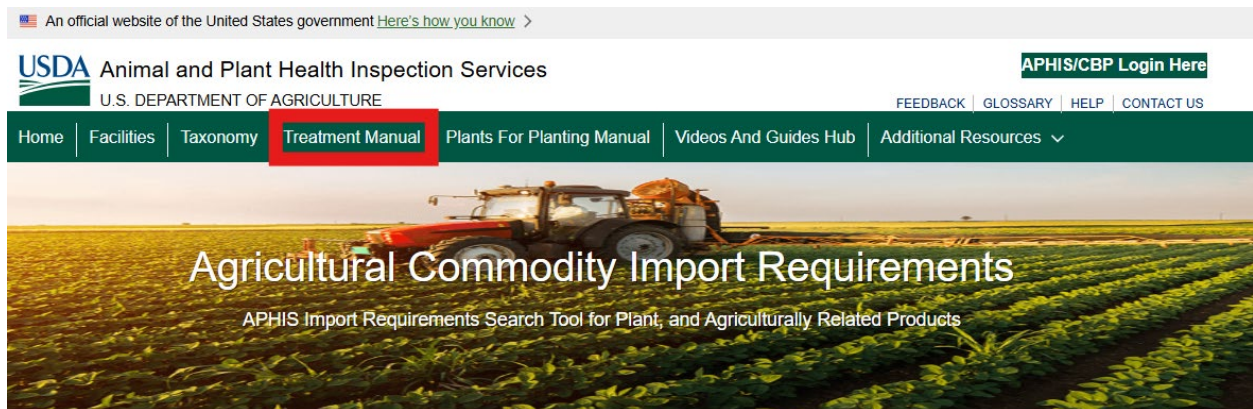


Domestic Treatment Manual Navigation Guide
